11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a
14 legislative rule relating to the qualifications, training and
15 examination of licensure of instructors.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
20 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the

1 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
2 authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty, of
3 this code, modified by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to
4 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee
5 and refiled in the state register on the eighteenth day of October,
6 two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Barbers and
7 Cosmetologists (qualifications, training, examination of licensure
8 of instructors, 3 CSR 2), is authorized.

10 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
11 Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
12 relating to the Qualifications, Training, Examination of Licensure
13 of Instructors.

14 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and
15 underscoring have been omitted.
