A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of

13

West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the

14

Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to

15

promulgate a legislative rule relating to law-enforcement

16

training standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,

as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction.

The legislative rule filed in the state register on the

24

twenty-third day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the

1 authority of section three, article twenty-nine, chapter thirty, of
2 this code, modified by the Governor's Committee on Crime,
3 Delinquency and Correction to meet the objections of the
4 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the state
5 register on the thirteenth day of October, two thousand ten,
6 relating to the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and
7 Correction (law enforcement training standards, 149 CSR 2), is
8 authorized.

9

10 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's
11 Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a
12 legislative rule relating to Law Enforcement Training Standards.

13

14 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and
15 underscoring have been omitted.
