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11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule
14 relating to long-term care insurance.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-7-1. Insurance Commissioner.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section three, article two, chapter thirty-three, of
24 this code, modified by the Insurance Commissioner to meet the

1 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
2 refiled in the state register on the twenty-eighth day of
3 September, two thousand ten, relating to the Insurance Commissioner
4 (long-term care insurance, 114 CSR 32), is authorized.

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6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Insurance
7 Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Long-term
8 Care Insurance.

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10 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and
11 underscoring have been omitted.
