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10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing  
12 Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
13 the supervision of elevator mechanics and apprentices.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia,  
16 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR BUREAU OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE**  
18 **LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-10-1. Division of Labor.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the  
21 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the  
22 authority of section eleven, article three-c, chapter twenty-one,

1 of this code, modified by the Division of Labor to meet the  
2 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and  
3 refiled in the state register on the twenty-third day of September,  
4 two thousand ten, relating to the Division of Labor (supervision of  
5 elevator mechanics and apprentices, 42 CSR 21A), is authorized.

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7 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of  
8 Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Supervision  
9 of Elevator Mechanics and Apprentices.

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11 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and  
12 underscoring have been omitted.
