21	The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22	thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the

authority of section six, article eight, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the Board of Optometry to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Optometry (rules of the West Virginia Board of Optometry, 14 CSR 1), is authorized.
