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10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating
13 to contact lenses that contain and deliver pharmaceutical
14 agents' certificates.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Optometry.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the

1 authority of section six, article eight, chapter thirty, of this
2 code, modified by the Board of Optometry to meet the objections of
3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the
4 state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand
5 ten, relating to the Board of Optometry (contact lenses that
6 contain and deliver pharmaceutical agents certificates, 14 CSR 9),
7 is authorized.

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NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Contact Lenses That Contain and Deliver Pharmaceutical Agents Certificates.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
