10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Osteopathy to promulgate a legislative rule relating
13 to osteopathic physician assistants.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathy.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
21 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
22 authority of section one, article fourteen-a, chapter thirty, of

1 this code, modified by the Board of Osteopathy to meet the
2 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
3 refiled in the state register on the twenty-ninth day of November,
4 two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Osteopathy (osteopathic
5 physician assistants, 24 CSR 2), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Osteopathic Physician Assistants.
