10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule
13 relating to fees for physical therapists and physical
14 therapist assistants.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Physical Therapy.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section six, article twenty, chapter thirty, of this
24 code, relating to the Board of Physical Therapy (fees for physical

1 therapists and physical therapist assistants, 16 CSR 4), is
2 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Fees for Physical Therapists and Physical Therapist Assistants.
