11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule
14 relating to general provisions for athletic trainers.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Physical Therapy.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section four, article twenty-a, chapter thirty, of
24 this code, modified by the Board of Physical Therapy to meet the

1 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
2 refiled in the state register on the twentieth day of September,
3 two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Physical Therapy
4 (general provisions for athletic trainers, 16 CSR 5), is
5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to General Provisions for Athletic Trainers.
