11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
13 Board of Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule  
14 relating to the organization and operation and licensing of  
15 veterinarians.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**  
20 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-9-1. Board of Veterinary Medicine.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the

1 twenty-seventh day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the  
2 authority of section six, article ten, chapter thirty, of this  
3 code, modified by the West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
4 authorizing the Board of Veterinary Medicine to meet the objections  
5 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the  
6 state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand  
7 ten, relating to the West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
8 the Board of Veterinary Medicine (organization and operation and  
9 licensing of veterinarians, 26 CSR 1), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of  
Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
the Organization and Operation and Licensing of Veterinarians.
