10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Board of Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule  
13 relating to certified animal euthanasia technicians.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**  
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Board of Veterinary Medicine.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the  
21 twenty-seventh day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the  
22 authority of section six, article ten, chapter thirty, of this

1 code, modified by the West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Board of Veterinary Medicine to meet the objections  
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the  
4 state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand  
5 ten, relating to the West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
6 the Board of Veterinary Medicine (certified animal euthanasia  
7 technicians, 26 CSR 5), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of  
Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
Certified Animal Euthanasia Technicians.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and
