11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of  
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing  
13 Workforce West Virginia to promulgate a legislative rule  
14 relating to the employer violator system.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR BUREAU OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE**  
19 **LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-10-1. Division of Natural Resources.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the twenty-  
22 fourth day of September, two thousand nine, authorized under the  
23 authority of section four, article one, chapter twenty-one-a, of  
24 this code, modified by Workforce West Virginia to meet the

1 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and  
2 refiled in the State Register on the eighteenth day of October, two  
3 thousand ten, relating to Workforce West Virginia (employer violator  
4 system, 96 CSR 3), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize Workforce West Virginia to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Employer Violator System.
