11	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
12	adding thereto a new section, designated §17B-3-14, relating
13	to motor vehicle driver's licenses; establishing a driver's
14	license restoration program; making legislative findings; and
15	granting rule-making authority.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
18	by adding thereto a new section, designated §17B-3-14, to read as
19	follows:
20	ARTICLE 3. CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF LICENSES.
21	<pre>§17B-3-14. Legislative findings; license restoration program;</pre>
22	rulemaking.
23	(a) The Legislature finds:
24	(1) That a growing number of drivers in the State of West

1 Virginia have their driver's licenses suspended or revoked each
2 year;

3 (2) That a majority of the suspension and revocation actions 4 undertaken by the Division of Motor Vehicles are for nondriving 5 related reasons including the nonpayment of citations and a variety 6 of other nonsafety related reasons;

7 (3) That there is a clear relationship between citizens having 8 a valid driver's license and the ability to gain and maintain 9 stable employment and other important matters affecting the quality 10 of life of citizens throughout the state; and

11 (4) That there are many areas within the state that are not 12 adequately served by public transportation which constitute a 13 reasonable alternative to transportation by means other than a 14 privately owned vehicle requiring the operator to have a valid 15 driver's license.

16 (b) The division is hereby required to establish a driver's 17 license restoration program within its driver services section.

(c) The driver's license restoration program is responsible for providing information and other educational services intended to assist persons in the reinstatement of their driving privileges after their drivers' licenses have been suspended or revoked. The program shall include, but is not limited to, the development of instructional materials suitable for use in providing driver's license reinstatement counseling that may be made available by

1 community-based social service agencies or other providers 2 recognizing the importance of reducing the economic and other 3 impacts associated with the suspension or revocation of drivers' 4 licenses.

5 (d) The commissioner shall:

6 (1) Develop information and educational materials necessary to 7 support the driver's license restoration program;

8 (2) Cooperate in the processing of information identifying the 9 specific driving history and the restoration requirements for 10 persons or counselors assisting those individuals whose drivers' 11 licenses have been suspended or revoked and who choose to 12 participate in a community-based program designed to assist in the

13 restoration of suspended or revoked drivers' licenses; and

14 (3) Make the program's services available at all regional 15 offices of the division and at all day report centers operated in 16 conjunction with community corrections programs throughout the 17 state. However, if there is not a regional office or a day report 18 center in a county, the commissioner shall provide the program's 19 services at another public meeting place in the county for which a 20 request for those services has been made.

(e) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative approval, in accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code, to implement the provisions of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish a driver's license restoration program for persons whose motor vehicle driver's license has been cancelled, suspended or revoked. The bill also makes legislative findings and grants rule-making authority.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
