17 A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of  
18 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
19 Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a  
20 legislative rule relating to licensed retailer operations.

21 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

22 That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
23 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

24 **ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO**

1           **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

2   **§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.**

3           The legislative rule filed in the state register on the  
4 twentieth day of November, two thousand nine, authorized under the  
5 authority of section six, article three-a, chapter sixty, of this  
6 code, modified by the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to meet  
7 the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and  
8 refiled in the state register on the nineteenth day of January, two  
9 thousand eleven, relating to the Alcohol Beverage Commission  
10 (licensed retailer operations, 175 CSR 1), is authorized.

12           NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol  
13 Beverage Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
14 Licensed Retailer Operations.
