Wagering at animal fighting prohibited; penalty. 23 (a) It is unlawful for any person to bet or wager money or any 24 other thing of value in any location or place where an animal

- 3 supervise, direct, lease or own all or a part of a business or
- 4 premises involving betting or wagering on an animal fighting

- 7 (c) Any person who violates the provisions of this section is
- 8 guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be
- 9 imprisoned in a state correctional facility for not less than one
- 10 year, fined not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000, or both
- 11 imprisoned and fined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to make wagering at animal fighting ventures and conducting, financing, managing, supervising, owning or leasing any part of an animal fighting venture or the premises on which it takes place with knowledge that wagering is occurring a felony.
