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In any billing statement submitted to an insured for payment of any premium due under a policy of fire insurance, covering property located in West Virginia, the insurer shall indicate the increased cost that fire insurance would cost, except for the sexistence of the local fire department, whether the department is ovoluntary or professional.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require insurance companies to reflect on billing statements the increased cost of fire insurance in the event no local fire department existed.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.

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
