

Senate Bill No. 498

(By Senators Beach, Snyder, Edgell and Klempa)

[Introduced February 11, 2011; referred to the Committee on the
Judiciary; and then to the Committee on Finance.]

A BILL to amend and reenact §60-3A-18 of the Code of West
Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to permitting the sale of
liquor on election day.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §60-3A-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be
amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3A. SALES BY RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSEES.

§60-3A-18. Days and hours retail licensees may sell liquor.

Retail licensees may not sell liquor on Sundays and Christmas ~~or~~
~~election~~ day, or between the hours of twelve midnight and eight
o'clock a.m., except that wine and fortified wines may be sold on
~~such~~ those days and at such times as authorized in section
thirty-four, article eight of this chapter.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit the sale of liquor

on election days.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
