22	ARTICLE 3D. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE.
23	§18B-3D-5. Legislative and emergency rules.
24	(a) The council shall propose a legislative rule pursuant to

article three-a, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code to implement 1 the provisions of this article and shall file the rule with the 2 Legislative Oversight Commission on Education Accountability no 3 4 later than the first day of September, two thousand six October 1, 5 2011.

6 (b) The Legislature finds that an emergency exists and, 7 therefore, the council shall propose an emergency rule to implement the provisions of this article in accordance with section six, 8 article one of this chapter and article three-a, chapter twenty-9 nine-a of this code by October 1, 2011. 10

(c) Any rule promulgated by the West Virginia Development 11 Office council pursuant to previous enactments of this section and 12 in effect on the effective date of the amendment and reenactment of 13 14 this section in the year two thousand six 2011 remains in effect until amended, modified, repealed or replaced by the council. 15

16 §18B-3D-6. Learn and Earn Cooperative Education Program 17 established.

18 (a) Legislative findings.

The Legislature finds that many West Virginians, 19 (1)particularly young adults, cannot enroll full-time in a community 20 and technical college technical program because circumstances 21 22 require them to maintain full-time employment. It is critically 23 important that technical programs leading to high-wage occupations be more accessible and affordable for all West Virginians. 24

1 (2) The Legislature further finds that cooperative education programs are successful in providing access to these technical 2 programs while providing students enrolled full-time in a community 3 and technical college with the financial benefits they need to 4 5 continue their education. These cooperative education programs 6 provide opportunities for students to work with West Virginia 7 companies while in college, thus increasing the likelihood that they will complete the program, find gainful employment and choose 8 to remain in West Virginia upon graduation. They provide students 9 10 with hands-on, real world work experience with a salary while they complete a technical program of study and, at the same time, 11 provide employers with a cost-effective tool for recruiting and 12 13 training.

(b) The purpose of this section is to establish a cooperative education program, under the jurisdiction of the council, as a component of the Workforce Development Initiative Program established pursuant to this article. The program shall be known and may be cited as the "Learn and Earn Program".

(c) The program requires a dollar-for-dollar cash match from participating employers or groups of employers from which the student receives a salary from the employer or employers while participating in the program. Participants may not substitute a match in-kind for the cash match required by this section.

24 (d) An institution is eligible to apply for a program grant in

1 cooperation with one or more employer partners if it meets the 2 definition of a community and technical college provided in section 3 two, article one of this chapter. The council shall define the 4 application process in the rules required in section five of this 5 article.

6 (e) The council may expend funds available through the 7 Workforce Development Initiative program to implement the 8 provisions of this section.

(NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish the Learn and Earn Cooperative Education Program between eligible community and technical colleges and participating companies for students enrolled in technical programs and to provide for legislative and emergency rules to implement the program.
