11 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
12 adding thereto a new section, designated §16-29B-20a, relating
13 to confidentiality of the rate-setting model.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
16 by adding thereto a new section, designated §16-29B-20a, to read as
17 follows:

18 **ARTICLE 29B. HEALTH CARE AUTHORITY.**

19 **§16-29B-20a. Confidentiality of the rate setting model.**

20 In its decision making process on standard rate applications,
21 the board utilizes a computer program known as the rate setting
22 model to generate options for the board. The board options are
23 various calculated rates that the board may elect to award to the
24 hospital. The rate setting model is pre-decisional in nature and

1 part of the deliberative process and, as such, shall be exempt from
2 public disclosure.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt the rate setting
model from disclosure.
