1 (b) The membership of an existing planning commission continue 2 unchanged until the first regular meeting, after the effective date 3 of this section, of the county commission that established the 4 planning commission. At that time, any appointments or changes 5 necessary shall be made to bring the membership of the existing 6 planning commission into conformity with this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require equal numbers of members from each magisterial district on county planning commissions.
