6 Requesting the Division of Highways to name bridge number 10-60-  
7        10.57 on US Route 60 in Gauley Bridge, West Virginia, the  
8        "Sgt. Scott Angel Memorial Bridge".

9        Whereas, Sgt. Scott Angel was born and raised in Gauley  
10 Bridge, West Virginia; and

11       Whereas, Sgt. Scott Angel was a graduate of Valley High School  
12 at Smithers, where he was a quarterback for the football team and  
13 captain of the baseball team; and

14       Whereas, Besides playing football and baseball at school he  
15 spent time enjoying the outdoors while hunting and fishing; and

16       Whereas, Sgt. Scott Angel served three tours of duty in Iraq  
17 during Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

18       Whereas, While Sgt. Scott Angel was not bravely serving  
19 overseas he was a helicopter repairman and crew chief assigned to  
20 Company C, 4th Battalion, 101st Aviation Regiment, 159th Combat  
21 Aviation Brigade, 101st Airborne Division at Fort Campbell,  
22 Kentucky; and

23       Whereas, While training in Alabama on September 11, 2007 he  
24 was killed in a Blackhawk crash; and

1           Whereas, Sgt. Angel was survived by his loving wife Megan and  
2 his infant daughter, Sophia; and

3           Whereas, In 2008, on the first anniversary of his death, the  
4 conference room at his Battalion Headquarters at Ft. Campbell was  
5 named the "SSA Conference room" in honor of Scott and the other two  
6 fallen soldiers involved in the Blackhawk accident; and

7           Whereas, He was also included in a cookbook, "Dinner with  
8 Warriors" that was published in honor of fallen and injured  
9 soldiers from the Iraq and Afghanistan wars; therefore, be it

10           *Resolved by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

11           That the Division of Highways is hereby requested to name  
12 bridge number 10-60-10.57 on US Route 60 in Gauley Bridge, West  
13 Virginia, the "Sgt. Scott Angel Memorial Bridge"; and, be it

14           *Further Resolved,* That the Division of Highways is requested  
15 to have made and be placed signs identifying the bridge as the  
16 "Sgt. Scott Angel Memorial Bridge"; and, be it

17           *Further Resolved,* That the Clerk of the Senate is hereby  
18 directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the  
19 Secretary of Transportation, the Commissioner of Highways and the  
20 family of the late Sgt. Scott Angel.
