

H. B. 2557

[Introduced January 19, 2011; referred to the
Committee on Political Subdivisions then the Judiciary.]

A BILL to extend the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County, West Virginia, to meet as a levying body for the purpose of submitting to the voters of that county an election on the question of the approval of a special levy for the payment of principal and interest on bond indebtedness authorized pursuant to Section 10, Article X of the West Virginia Constitution until the last day in May, 2011, that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Extending the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County to meet as levying body for election to consider the question of a bond levy.

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter
2 eleven of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, to
3 the contrary, the Board of Education of Upshur County, West
4 Virginia, is authorized to extend the time for its meeting as
5 a levying body, setting the levying rate and certifying its
6 actions to the Auditor until the last day in May, 2011, that is
7 not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, for the purpose of
8 submitting to the voters of that county an election on the
9 question of the approval of a special levy for the payment of
10 principal and interest on bond indebtedness authorized
11 pursuant to Section 10, Article X of the West Virginia
12 Constitution.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to extend the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County to meet as a levying body to present to the voters of Upshur County the question of a bond levy.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
