H. B. 2557

(BY DELEGATES M. POLING, HAMILTON AND SMITH)

[Introduced January 19, 2011; referred to the Committee on Political Subdivisions then the Judiciary.]

A BILL to extend the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County, West Virginia, to meet as a levying body for the purpose of submitting to the voters of that county an election on the question of the approval of a special levy for the payment of principal and interest on bond indebtedness authorized pursuant to Section 10, Article X of the West Virginia Constitution until the last day in May, 2011, that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

<u>§1. Extending the time for the Board of Education of Upshur</u> <u>County to meet as levying body for election to consider</u> <u>the question of a bond levy.</u>

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter
- 2 eleven of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, to
- 3 the contrary, the Board of Education of Upshur County, West
- 4 <u>Virginia, is authorized to extend the time for its meeting as</u>
- 5 <u>a levying body, setting the levying rate and certifying its</u>
- 6 actions to the Auditor until the last day in May, 2011, that is
- 7 not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, for the purpose of
- 8 submitting to the voters of that county an election on the
- 9 question of the approval of a special levy for the payment of
- 10 principal and interest on bond indebtedness authorized
- 11 pursuant to Section 10, Article X of the West Virginia
- 12 Constitution.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to extend the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County to meet as a levying body to present to the voters of Upshur County the question of a bond levy.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
