A BILL to amend and reenact §18-5-9a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to lease purchase contracts for energy-saving measures and energy-saving contracts entered into by county boards; and allowing these contracts to have a term of up to fifteen years.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §18-5-9a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-5-9a. Energy-savings contracts.

1 (a) For the purposes of this section: (1) "Energy-conservation measures" means goods or 2 3 services, or both, to reduce energy consumption operating costs of school facilities. They These include, but are not 4 5 limited to, installation of two or more of the following: 6 (A) Insulation of a building structure and systems within 7 a building; (B) Storm windows or doors, caulking or weather 8 9 stripping, multiglazed multi-glazed windows or doors, 10 heat-absorbing or heat-reflective glazed and coated window 11 or door systems or other window or door modifications that

- 12 reduce energy consumption;
- 13 (C) Automatic energy control systems;

(D) Heating, ventilating or air conditioning systems,including modifications or replacements;

16 (E) Replacement or modification of lighting fixtures to17 increase energy efficiency;

18 (F) Energy recovery systems;

(G) Cogeneration <u>Co-generation</u> systems that produce
steam or another form of energy for use by the county board
of education in a building or complex of buildings owned by
the Board of Education; or

23 (H) Energy-conservation maintenance measures that
24 provide long-term operating cost reductions of the building's
25 present cost of operation.

(2) "Energy-savings contract" means a contract for the 26 evaluation and recommendation of energy operations 27 conservation measures and for implementation of one or 28 The contract shall provide that 29 more such measures. 30 payments, except obligations upon termination of the contract 31 before its expiration, are to be made over time. A county board of education may supplement these payments with 32 33 federal, state or local funds to reduce the annual cost or to lower the initial amount to be financed. 34

35 (3) "Qualified provider" means a person, firm or
36 corporation experienced in the design, implementation and
37 installation of energy-conservation measures.

38 (b) County boards of education are hereby authorized to39 enter into performance-based contracts with qualified

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40 providers of energy-conservation measures for the purpose of41 reducing energy operating costs of school buildings.

42 (c) A board of education may enter into an energy-savings contract with a qualified provider to reduce 43 44 energy operating costs significantly reduce energy operating 45 costs. Before entering into such a contract or before the installation of equipment, modifications or remodeling to be 46 47 furnished under such a contract, the qualified provider shall 48 first issue a proposal summarizing the scope of work to be performed. Such a proposal shall contain estimates of all 49 50 costs of installation, modifications or remodeling including 51 the costs of design, engineering, installation, maintenance, 52 repairs or debt service as well as estimates of the amounts by 53 which energy operating costs will be reduced. If the board 54 finds, after receiving the proposal, that the proposal includes 55 more than one energy-conservation measure designed to save 56 energy operating costs, the board may enter into a contract 57 with the provider pursuant to this section.

58 (d) An energy-savings contract must shall include the59 following:

60 (1) A guarantee of a specific minimum amount of money
61 that the board will save in energy operating costs each year
62 during the term of the contract; and

63 (2) A statement of all costs of energy-conservation
64 measures including the costs of design, engineering,
65 installation, maintenance, repairs and operations.

66 (e) An energy-savings contract which is 67 performance-based and includes a guarantee of savings and 68 a comprehensive approach of energy-conservation measures for improving comfort is subject to competitive bidding 69 requirements. *Provided*, That The requirements of article 70 71 five-a, chapter twenty-one of this code as to prevailing wage 72 rates shall apply to the construction and installation work performed under such a contract. 73

(f) A board may enter into a "lease with an option to purchase" contract for the purchase and installation of energy-conservation measures if the term of the lease does not exceed ten <u>fifteen</u> years and the lease contract includes the provisions hereinafter contained in subsection (g) and meets federal tax requirements for tax-exempt municipal leasing or long-term financing.

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81	(g) An energy-savings contract may extend beyond the
82	fiscal year in which it first becomes effective Provided,
83	except that such a contract may not exceed a ten fifteen-year
84	term Provided, however, That such long term contract and
85	shall be void unless such agreement shall provide that the
86	board shall have the option thereunder during each fiscal year
87	of the contract to terminate the agreement. provides the board
88	the option to terminate the agreement during each fiscal year
89	of the contract. The board may include in its annual budget
90	for each fiscal year any amounts payable under long-term
91	energy-savings contracts during that fiscal year. Provided

93	(h) Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to require
94	or permit in this section requires or permits the replacement

95 of jobs performed by service personnel employed by the local

96 school board pursuant to sections eight and eight-a, article

97 four, chapter eighteen-a of the code, as amended.
