A BILL to amend and reenact §3-5-17 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to changing the date of the canvassing of votes in a primary election from the Friday following a primary election to the Monday following a primary election.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §3-5-17 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 5. PRIMARY ELECTIONS AND NOMINATING PROCEDURES.

## §3-5-17. Canvassing and certifying returns; recount procedures.

The county court, commissioners of the county 1 commission, sitting as a board of canvassers, shall meet 2 3 convene at the courthouse of the county on the Friday next 4 succeeding fifth day following any primary election, which 5 is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, and shall proceed 6 to canvass the returns of such the election. The procedures prescribed in section nine, of article six, of this chapter 7 8 relating to canvass of general election returns, shall, where 9 adaptable, be applied in the canvass of the primary election 10 returns. The board shall proceed to ascertain the result of 11 such the election in the county and district and election 12 precincts thereof and cause to be prepared and recorded in 13 the primary election precinct record book a table or tables 14 which shall show, as to each candidate of each political party 15 for each office, the number of votes cast for him or her at 16 each precinct and the total number thereof cast in the entire county. The board shall then make up and enter in said 17 18 record book a certificate for each political party showing, as 19 to each candidate for each political party for each office, the 20 total number of votes, in words and also in figures, cast for 21 him or her in the entire county and the number of votes

The provisions of article six of this chapter, relating to the recount of votes in general elections, shall, to the extent applicable, be operative in primary and other elections conducted under provisions of this article.
