## H.B. 3031

(BY DELEGATES MORGAN AND HATFIELD)

[Introduced February 7, 2011; referred to the Committee on Government Organization then the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §30-1-20, relating to authorizing professional licensing boards to obtain criminal history record checks; authorizing boards to obtain criminal history information on license applicants and licensees; providing the board rule-making authority to establish procedures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §30-1-20, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL STATE BOARDS OF EXAMINATION OR REGISTRATION REFERRED TO IN CHAPTER.

## §30-1-20. Boards may obtain criminal history record checks on an applicant for an authorization to practice a profession.
