| 22     | §5A-3-52. Special funds for travel management created.                                   |
| 23     | (a) The travel management special fund is terminated. All                                |
| 24     | deposits currently in this special fund from aviation fees shall be                      |
| 25     | transferred into the Aviation Fund. All funds in this special fund                       |
| 26     | from the monthly fee for vehicles shall be transferred into the                          |

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1 Fleet Management Office Fund.

2 (b) There is created in the State Treasury a special revenue 3 account, to be known as the "Fleet Management Office Fund". 4 Expenditures are authorized from collections but are to be made 5 only in accordance with appropriation by the Legislature and in 6 accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twelve of 7 this code and upon fulfillment of the provisions of article two, 8 chapter eleven-b of this code. Any balance remaining in the special 9 revenue account at the end of any state fiscal year does not revert 10 to the General Revenue Fund but remains in the special revenue 11 account and shall be used solely in a manner consistent with this 12 section. All costs and expenses incurred pursuant to this section, 13 including administrative, shall be paid from this funds. Any 14 institution, agency or department shall pay any charges for 15 operating, repairing and servicing motor vehicles it uses into the 16 Fleet Management Office Fund.

17 (c) There is created in the State Treasury a special revenue 18 account, to be known as the "Aviation Fund".
