15	Protection Fund; providing a three-month grace period for
16	volunteer fire companies or departments to comply with
17	submission of data; requiring the State Fire Marshal to notify
18	these volunteer fire companies or departments of the dates and
19	grace period; and providing a three-month exemption to
20	volunteer fire companies or departments whose records were
21	destroyed from requirements to submit data.
22	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
23	That $\$8-15-8a$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
24	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
25	ARTICLE 15. FIRE FIGHTING; FIRE COMPANIES AND DEPARTMENTS; CIVIL

1 SERVICE FOR PAID FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

- 2 §8-15-8a. Eligibility for allocation from municipal pensions and
- 3 protection fund and the Fire Protection Fund.
- 4 (a) In order to be eligible to receive revenues allocated from
- 5 the municipal pensions and protection fund or the Fire Protection
- 6 Fund, each volunteer or part volunteer fire company or department
- 7 must meet the following requirements: listed in subdivisions (a)
- 8 through (c) of this section.
- 9 Each volunteer or part volunteer fire company or department
- 10 must:
- 11 (a) (1) Submit and maintain current submission of fire loss
- 12 data to the State Fire Marshal, including verification, by notarized
- 13 statement, if no fire loss has occurred;
- (b) (2) Complete or be in the process of receiving firefighters
- 15 training, including section one of the West Virginia University fire
- 16 service extension or its equivalent. Such The fire company or
- 17 department must have at least ten members certified as having
- 18 completed such the training or if a volunteer fire company or
- 19 department has twenty or fewer members, fifty percent of the active
- 20 volunteer members must have completed such training; and
- $\frac{\text{(c)}}{\text{(3)}}$ Comply with all applicable federal and state laws.
- 22 (b) Each volunteer or part volunteer fire company or department
- 23 shall have a grace period of one fiscal quarter, or three months,
- 24 beyond the allocation date in which to comply with submission
- 25 requirements to the State Fire Marshal. The State Fire Marshal

- 1 shall notify each volunteer or part volunteer fire company or
- 2 department of the due date for submitting the information required
- 3 by this section and the grace period. The Fire Marshal shall use
- 4 every means available to notify each volunteer or part volunteer
- 5 fire company or department in order to ensure timely compliance with
- 6 this section.
- 7 (c) When the records of a volunteer or part volunteer fire
- 8 company or department are destroyed by a means beyond the control
- 9 of the volunteer or part volunteer fire company or department, then
- 10 the affected volunteer or part volunteer fire company or department
- 11 is exempt from the provisions of subdivision (1), subsection (a) of
- 12 this section, for the three months period immediately following the
- 13 destruction of the records.

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
