12	A BILL to amend and reenact $\S62-12-12$ of the Code of West
13	Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to qualification of

15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §62-12-12 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
17	amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 12. PROBATION AND PAROLE.
19	§62-12-12. Parole board generally.
20	There shall be a state board of parole, known as <u>(a)</u> The
21	West Virginia Parole Board is continued. The board shall consist
22	of nine members, each of whom shall have been a resident of this
23	state for at least five consecutive years prior to his or her

1 appointment. No more than five of the board members may at any 2 one time belong to the same political party. The board shall be 3 appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of 4 the Senate.

5 (b) Appointments following the effective date of this 6 section shall be made in such a manner that each congressional 7 district is represented and so that no more than four and no less 8 than two members of the board reside in any one congressional 9 district. No more than two members of the board may reside in 10 any one county. Each member of the board shall have a degree in 11 criminal justice, or like experience and academic training

12 (c) Any person initially appointed to the board on or after 13 July 1, 2012, shall have at least a baccalaureate degree from an 14 accredited college or university and at least five years of 15 actual experience in the fields of penology, corrections, law 16 enforcement, sociology, law, education, psychology, social work, 17 medicine or a combination thereof and shall be otherwise 18 competent to perform the duties of his or her office. The 19 members shall be appointed for overlapping terms of six years. 20 Any member qualified under this section is Members are eligible 21 for reappointment. The members of the board shall devote their 22 full time and attention to their board duties. The Governor 23 shall appoint one of the nine appointed members to serve as 24 chairperson at the Governor's will and pleasure.
