18	ARTICLE 2.ASSESSORS.	
19	§11-2-12. Access to commercial or residential review documents.	
20	A county assessor shall provide a person, who is a licenced	
21	real estate appraiser under article thirty-eight, chapter thirty of	
22	this code, copies of commercial or residential review documents on	
23	the assessor's computerized assessment system, and may charge a fee	
24	of no more than \$10 per form. These forms shall be obtained for the	
25	sole purpose of determining comparable market value of a property.	

- 1 Also, the assessor shall redact from the copies, information
- 2 pertaining to security systems, home safes and other information
- 3 that may jeopardize the security of the property or any possessions
- 4 therein.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit licensed real estate appraisers access to commercial or residential review documents. The bill also permits county assessors to charge no more than \$3 per form.
