

1 licenses, stamps or permits are required. It shall be issued only
2 to residents or aliens lawfully residing in the United States who
3 have been domiciled residents of West Virginia for a period of
4 thirty consecutive days or more immediately prior to the date of
5 their application for a license. The fee for the license is \$18:
6 Provided, That a Class B license is effective one year from the
7 date of purchase of the license. To fish for trout, a Class B
8 license holder must purchase and carry a valid Class O stamp or
9 Class O-L license. This is a base license and does not require the
10 purchase of a prerequisite license to participate in the activities
11 specified in this section, except as noted.

12 **§20-2-42f. Class F nonresident fishing license.**

13 A Class F license is a nonresident fishing license and
14 entitles the licensee to fish for all legal fish except trout and
15 to take frogs, in all counties of the state except as prohibited by
16 rules of the Director or Natural Resources Commission and except
17 when additional licenses, stamps or permits are required. The fee
18 for the license is \$35: Provided, That a Class F license is
19 effective one year from the date of purchase of the license. To
20 fish for trout, a Class F license holder must purchase and carry a
21 valid Class OO trout stamp. This is a base license and does not
22 require the purchase of a prerequisite license to participate in
23 the activities specified in this section, except as noted.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that a Class B resident fishing license and a Class F nonresident fishing license are effective one year from the date of purchase of the license.
