13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That §17-3A-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
15	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 3A. INDUSTRIAL ACCESS ROAD FUND.
17	§17-3A-1. Industrial access road fund created; construction
18	guarantees by municipalities and counties.
19	(a) Any other provision of this code notwithstanding, there is
20	hereby continued in the State Treasury the "industrial access road
21	fund", referred to in this article as "the fund". There shall be
22	deposited into the fund three fourths of one percent of all state
23	tax collections which are otherwise specifically dedicated by the
24	provisions of this code to the state road fund or the percentage of

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1 those tax collections that will produce \$3 million for each fiscal

2 year. At the end of each fiscal year, all <del>unused</del> <u>unobligated</u>

3 moneys in the fund revert to the state road fund.

(b) The moneys in the fund shall be expended by the Division of Highways for constructing and maintaining industrial access roads within counties and municipalities to industrial sites on which manufacturing, distribution, processing or other economic development activities, including publicly owned airports, are already constructed or are under firm contract to be constructed. In the event there is no industrial site already constructed or for which the construction is under firm contract, a county or municipality may guarantee to the Division of Highways an acceptable surety or a device in an amount equal to the estimated cost of the access road or that portion provided by the Division of Highways, that an industrial site will be constructed and if no industrial site acceptable to the Division of Highways is rootstructed within the time limits of the surety or device, the surety or device shall be forfeited.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to correct current legislation that requires any unused industrial funds to return to the road fund. The amendment allows for all unobligated funds to return to the road fund.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
