16 ARTICLE 2. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE, EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL.
17 §17B-2-12. Expiration of licenses.
18 (a) Except as provided in subsection subsections (b) and (c)
19 of this section, every driver's license shall expire five years from
20 the date of its issuance.
21 (b)(1) Every driver's license issued to a person who has
22 attained his or her twenty-first birthday shall expire on the
23 licensee's birthday in those years in which the licensee's age is
24 evenly divisible by five. Except as provided in the following

25 subdivisions and in subsection (c) of this section, no driver's

llicense may be issued for less than three years or for more than 2 seven years and shall be valid for a period of five years, expiring 3 on the licensee's birthday in a year in which the licensee's age is 4 evenly divisible by five.

- 5 (2) Every driver's license issued to a person who has not 6 attained his or her twenty-first birthday shall expire thirty days 7 after the licensee's twenty-first birthday, except as provided in 8 section three-a of this article.
- 9 (3) The driver's license of any person in the member of United

 10 States Armed Forces and that of his or her spouse shall expire six

 11 months after the date on which the person member is separated from

 12 active duty in the Armed Forces under honorable circumstances.
- 13 (c) A license issued to a person who is not a citizen of the 14 United States may only be issued for the time the person is legally 15 authorized to be in the United States, not to exceed five years. 16 If the time the person is authorized to be in the United States is 17 extended, the commissioner may renew the license in accordance with 18 section twelve-a of this article for the time extended, not to 19 exceed five years.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to extend the expiration of the driver's licenses of military members' spouses.
