10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a
13 legislative rule relating to the procedures, criteria and
14 curricula for examinations and licensure of barbers,
15 cosmetologists, manicurists and aestheticians.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
20 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
23 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the
24 authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty, of
25 this code, relating to the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists

1 (procedures, criteria and curricula for examinations and licensure
2 of barbers, cosmetologists, manicurists and aestheticians, [3 CSR](#)
3 [1](#)), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
6 Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
7 relating to the Procedures, Criteria and Curricula for Examinations
8 and Licensure of Barbers, Cosmetologists, Manicurists and
9 Aestheticians.
