10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
13 the Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the
22 authority of section three hundred one, article three, chapter
23 sixty-a, of this code, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Uniform
24 Controlled Substances Act, [15 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

26 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
27 Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Uniform

1 Controlled Substances Act.
