10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a  
13 legislative rule relating to licensing schools of barbering  
14 and beauty culture.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**  
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
22 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the  
23 authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty, of  
24 this code, modified by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to  
25 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee

1 and refiled in the State Register on the twentieth day of  
2 September, two thousand eleven, relating to the Board of Barbers  
3 and Cosmetologists (licensing schools of barbering and beauty  
4 culture, [3 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of  
7 Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule  
8 relating to Licensing Schools of Barbering and Beauty Culture.
