[Introduced January 19, 2012; referred to the Committee on Health  
and Human Resources then the Judiciary.]

10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Division of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule  
13 relating to family child care home registration requirements.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**  
18 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-5-1. Division of Human Services.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
21 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the  
22 authority of section four, article two-b, chapter forty-nine, of  
23 this code, modified by the Division of Human Services to meet the  
24 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and  
25 refiled in the State Register on the twenty-third day of November,  
26 two thousand eleven, relating to the Division of Human Services

1 (family child care home registration requirements, [78 CSR 19](#)), is  
2 authorized.

4 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of  
5 Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Family  
6 Child Care Home Registration Requirements.
