



1 article, the following persons are entitled to register in person  
2 at the office of the clerk of the county commission up to, but not  
3 including, the day of the election:

4 (1) Any member of a uniformed service of the United States, as  
5 defined in 42 U.S.C. § 1973ff-6 (7), who is on active duty;

6 (2) Any member of the Merchant Marine of the United States;

7 (3) Any person who resides temporarily outside of the United  
8 States; and

9 (4) Any spouse or dependent residing with a person listed in  
10 subdivision 1, 2 or 3 of this subsection.

11 The provisions of this subsection apply only to those persons  
12 who are otherwise qualified to register and who, by reason of such  
13 active duty or temporary overseas residency, either; (i) Are  
14 normally absent from the county in which they reside; or (ii) have  
15 been absent from such county and returned to reside there during  
16 the twenty-one days immediately preceding the election.

17 (b) Any person who was on active duty as a member of a  
18 uniformed service of the United States and discharged from the  
19 uniformed service during the sixty days immediately preceding the  
20 election, and the member's spouse or dependent, are entitled to  
21 register, if otherwise qualified, in person up to, but not  
22 including, the day of the election.

23 (c) The Secretary of State shall prescribe procedures for the  
24 addition of persons registered under this section to the lists of

1 registered voters.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide late voter registration opportunities to individuals covered by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Act of 1986 for a period up to, but not to include, election day.
