- (d) The State Fire Commission shall develop minimum training 9 levels for firefighters, minimum levels of equipment needed to 10 protect life and property within fire service areas, minimum 11 performance standards the departments must meet in response times, 12 communications, minimum levels of water flow and pressure and other 13 performance measures as considered necessary to meet the overall 14 goals of improved fire prevention and control. The State Fire 15 Commission may make recommendations to the State Insurance 16 Commissioner regarding town classifications for fire insurance

(h) The State Fire Marshal may accept, on behalf of the State Fire Commission, gifts, grants, court ordered civil forfeiture 14 proceedings and bequests of funds or property from individuals, 15 foundations, corporations, the federal government, governmental agencies and other organizations or institutions. NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the State Fire Commission to implement standards regarding fire prevention, fire control, performance, equipment, certification, fire services training and responsibilities of fire departments throughout the state by legislative rule instead of by policy. The bill adds fire rescue service training and education to that list of standards.
