10	A BILL to authorize a Prince Railroad Station Authority to acquire
11	and maintain the railroad station building and the
12	appurtenances thereto located in Prince, West Virginia; to be
13	created as a public corporation; membership, terms and
14	compensation of the board; powers; exemption from taxation;
15	and dissolution of the authority.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	PRINCE RAILROAD STATION AUTHORITY.
18	§1. Legislative findings.
19	Since the railroad station located in Prince, West Virginia,
20	will be the primary stop for Boy Scouts riding trains to attend the
21	Bechtel Family Summit Scout Reserve in Fayette County, and since
22	the railroad station located in Prince is a vital transportation
23	facility for many residents in the area, and since the railroad
24	station located in Prince has potential for passenger inter-modal

25 operations, and since the railroad station located in Prince is

- 1 rich in railroad history and has architectural significance, the
- 2 Legislature finds that creating and empowering a statutory
- 3 corporation to work with railroad officials to acquire, renovate
- 4 and maintain the railroad station building and the appurtenances
- 5 thereto located in Prince, West Virginia, would be in the public
- 6 interest and would result in a better travel experience for all
- 7 persons coming to and leaving southern West Virginia.

# 8 §2. Prince Railroad Station Authority authorized.

- 9 The Fayette County Commission and the Raleigh County
- 10 commission are hereby authorized to create and establish the Prince
- 11 Railroad Station Authority for the purpose of acquiring,
- 12 establishing, renovating, constructing, equipping, improving,
- 13 financing, maintaining, operating and leasing the railroad station
- 14 building and the appurtenances thereto located in Prince, West
- 15 Virginia.

## 16 §3. The authority to be a public corporation.

- 17 The Prince Railroad Station Authority when created and
- 18 established, and the members thereof, shall constitute a public
- 19 corporation and as such, shall have perpetual succession, may
- 20 contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, and have and use
- 21 a common seal.

## 22 §4. Appointment of board; terms.

23 (a) The authority shall be governed by a nine-member board

24 which shall consist of the following members:

- 1 (1) A member of the Fayette County commission or a designee;
- 2 (2) A member of the Raleigh County commission or a designee;
- 3 (3) A member of the Southern West Virginia Convention and
- 4 Visitors Bureau or a designee;
- 5 (4) A member of the State Rail Authority or a designee;
- 6 (5) A member of the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce or a 7 designee;
- 8 (6) A member of the Raleigh County Chamber of Commerce or a 9 designee;
- 10 (7) The director of the Historic Preservation Section of the
- 11 West Virginia Division of Culture and History or a designee;
- 12 (8) One professional member of the Boy Scouts of America
- 13 representing the Bechtel Family Summit Scout Reserve, appointed by
- 14 the Fayette County commission; and
- 15 (9) One citizen member, appointed by the Raleigh County
- 16 commission, who has a knowledge of and demonstrates an interest in
- 17 passenger railroads and is from southern West Virginia.
- 18 (b) The initial appointment terms for the appointed members of
- 19 the board shall be staggered. After the initial terms, the terms
- 20 for the appointed members of the board shall be five years and they
- 21 may be reappointed.
- 22 §5. Compensation of board members.
- 23 Each member of the board shall serve without compensation, but
- 24 each member shall be entitled to reimbursement by the authority for

1 all reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in the 2 performance of his or her duties as a board member.

### 3 §6. Board; quorum; bylaws.

- 4 (a) The board is the governing body of the authority and the 5 board shall exercise all the powers given to the authority. The 6 board shall meet at least quarterly and may meet on the call of 7 the chairperson.
- 8 (b) A majority of the members of the board constitutes a 9 quorum and a quorum must be present for the board to conduct 10 business. Unless the bylaws require a larger number, action may 11 be taken by majority vote of the members present.
- 12 (c) The board shall adopt bylaws and rules, as may be
  13 necessary for its operation and management, governing the manner
  14 in which the business of the authority is conducted and shall
  15 develop and approve an annual budget.

### 16 §7. Powers of the authority.

- 17 The authority shall have the following powers:
- 18 (1) To make and adopt all necessary bylaws and rules for its 19 organization and operations not inconsistent with law;
- 20 (2) To elect its own officers, to appoint committees and to 21 employ and fix the compensation for personnel necessary for its 22 operation;
- 23 (3) To sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded and complain 24 and defend in any court;

- 1 (4) To execute contracts with any person, firm, corporation or 2 governmental agency;
- 3 (5) To obtain and maintain all necessary insurance;
- 4 (6) To insure that lessees maintain all necessary insurance;
- 5 (7) To delegate any authority given to it by law to any of its 6 officers, committees, agents or employees;
- 7 (8) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, sell, convey, lease and 8 dispose of property;
- 9 (9) To borrow money and execute negotiable notes and deeds of 10 trust;
- 11 (10) To expend its funds in the execution of its powers;
- 12 (11) To apply for, accept, receive and use loans, grants, 13 gifts, donations, contributions, technical assistance from any 14 source;
- 15 (12) To insure that all applicable laws, rules and regulations 16 are followed; and
- 17 (13) To do any and all things necessary or convenient for the 18 purpose of acquiring, establishing, renovating, constructing, 19 equipping, improving, financing, maintaining, operating and leasing 20 the railroad station building and the appurtenances thereto located 21 in Prince, West Virginia.

#### 22 §8. Exemption from taxation.

The property, operations and activities of the authority are 24 exempt from the payment of any taxes or fees to the state or any of

1 its political subdivisions.

## 2 §9. Dissolution of authority.

When the railroad station building and the appurtenances 4 thereto located in Prince, West Virginia, are no longer being used 5 for the purpose of a railroad station, then the authority shall 6 perform all its duties set out in the Deed in which it acquired the 7 railroad station building and the appurtenances thereto and also 8 all the duties set out in the authority's bylaws to dispose of the 9 railroad station building and the appurtenances thereto. At the 10 conclusion of all of its duties, the authority shall dissolve.

NOTE: The purpose of this local bill is to authorize a Prince Railroad Station Authority to acquire and maintain the railroad station building and the appurtenances thereto located in Prince, West Virginia.
