17	ARTICLE 9. OFFENSES AND PENALTIES.
18	<u>§3-9-14. Absentee ballot fraud; intimidation of voters;</u>
19	penalties.
20	Any person who obtains, removes, fills out or disseminates
21	absentee ballots or intimidates an absentee voter with the intent
22	to commit fraud is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof,
23	shall be fined not less than \$10,000 nor more than \$20,000 or
24	imprisoned in a state correctional facility not less than one nor

1 more than five years, or both fined and imprisoned.

2 For the purposes of this section, each ballot obtained shall
3 be considered a separate offense.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for a new felony of absentee ballot fraud.
