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10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new article, designated §9A-5-1, §9A-5-2,
12	\$9A-5-3, $$9A-5-4$, $$9A-5-5$, $$9A-5-6$ and $$9A-5-7$, all relating
13	to establishment of the West Virginia Board of Veteran
14	Education and Support; and authorizing powers and membership.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new article, designated \$9A-5-1, \$9A-5-2, \$9A-
18	5-3, §9A-5-4, §9A-5-5, §9A-5-6, §9A-5-7, all to read as follows:
19	ARTICLE 5. West Virginia Board of Veteran Education and Support.
20	§9A-5-1. Purpose.
21	(a) The Legislature finds that West Virginia veterans
22	represent a valuable component of the state's higher education
23	population. The pursuit of benefits and entitlements at both the

- 1 state and federal levels are foreboding to many veterans seeking
- 2 continuing education, while maintaining employment and other
- 3 obligations. It is, therefore, in the best interest of the state to
- 4 consolidate and network veterans resources and personnel in order
- 5 to ensure services to the state's veteran seeking continuing
- 6 education.
- 7 (b) The purpose of this article is to establish the West
- 8 Virginia Board of Veteran Education and Support for the purposes of
- 9 administering and networking the combined assets of Veteran's
- 10 Affairs personnel through out the state's institutions of higher
- 11 education and to foster connectivity and communication throughout
- 12 Veteran Affairs staff at institutions of higher learning throughout
- 13 the state.
- 14 **§9A-5-2**. **Definitions**.
- "Eligible veteran" for this article means a person who meets
- 16 the criteria established in article two, section four of this
- 17 chapter and is enrolled and in any of the state's higher education
- 18 institutions.
- 19 §9A-5-3. Board of Veterans Education and Support.
- The Legislature hereby authorizes the West Virginia Board of
- 21 Veteran Education and Support for the purpose of strategic planning
- 22 and programming, networking, and promoting open communication
- 23 throughout the various Offices of Veterans Affairs established on
- 24 the state's various institutions of higher education, dedicated to

- 1 the educational benefit of all state veterans.
- 2 §9A-5-4. Appointment of board; terms.
- 3 (a) The board shall be comprised of a single representative of
- 4 the various Offices of Veteran Affairs from each of the state's
- 5 <u>institutions of higher education that receive tuition assistance or</u>
- 6 any other funding from the United States Department of Veterans
- 7 Affairs.
- 8 (b) A staff member of any bona fide Reserve Officer Training
- 9 Corps is authorized board membership for his or her respective
- 10 higher learning institution; provided that the selection of
- 11 representation is agreed upon by both the ROTC unit staff and the
- 12 Office of Veteran Affairs of the respective schools.
- 13 (c) The initial appointment terms for the appointed members of
- 14 the board shall last one year. Board members may be reappointed
- 15 without a limit to consecutive terms. Board members serving as
- 16 chair person are ineligible for serving consecutive terms as chair.
- 17 §9A-5-5. Compensation of board members.
- 18 Each member of the board shall serve without compensation, but
- 19 each member shall be entitled to reimbursement by the state for all
- 20 reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in the
- 21 performance of his or her duties as a board member.
- 22 §9A-5-6. Board; quorum; bylaws.
- 23 (a) The board shall exercise all the powers given to the
- 24 authority. The board shall meet semiannually, after the completion

- 1 of the spring and fall enrollment dates pursuant to a consensus of
- 2 a majority of the aforementioned educational institutions.
- 3 (b) A majority of the members of the board constitutes a
- 4 quorum and a quorum must be present for the board to conduct
- 5 business. Unless expressly forbidden by state or federal
- 6 regulations, action may be taken by majority vote of the members
- 7 present.
- 8 (c) The board shall adopt bylaws and rules, as may be
- 9 necessary for its operation and management, governing the manner
- 10 in which the business of the board is conducted and shall schedule
- 11 semiannual meeting dates and times in accordance with
- 12 aforementioned semester schedules.
- 13 **§9A-5-7**. **Board Powers**.
- 14 The board shall have the following powers:
- 15 (a) To make and adopt all necessary rules for its organization
- 16 and operations not inconsistent with law;
- 17 (b) To elect its own chairperson from members currently
- 18 serving;
- 19 (1) Upon election and confirmation, the chair person shall be
- 20 responsible for supervising drafting and submission of the board's
- 21 semiannual reports to the West Virginia Legislature and the West
- 22 <u>Virginia Department of Veterans Assistance.</u>
- 23 (2) The chair person will serve as host and facilitator of the
- 24 semiannual board meetings.

- 1 (c) To develop and implement programming for the benefit all
- 2 veterans of the various campuses throughout the state;
- 3 (d) To pursue state and federal grants and other sources of
- 4 funding for staff and facilities pursuant to the purpose of veteran
- 5 education.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish the West Virginia Board of Veteran Education and Support.
