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10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new section, designated $\$5-22-3$ , relating to
12	government construction contracts; and providing
13	specifications for multiple prime contracts for certain public
14	works projects.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated $\$5-22-3$ , to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 22. GOVERNMENT CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.
20	§5-22-3. Multiple prime contracts and specifications for certain
21	public works projects.
22	(a) Whenever the state or any of its subdivisions, as defined
23	in section one, article twenty-two of this chapter are charged with

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1	the duty of preparing specifications or awarding or entering into
2	contracts for the erection, construction, reconstruction or
3	alteration of buildings, and when the entire cost of the public
4	work exceeds \$500,000, the state or the applicable subdivision
5	shall prepare separate bid proposals and bid specifications for the
6	following subdivisions of the work to be performed:
7	(1) Plumbing;
8	(2) Heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus;
9	(3) Electrical;
10	(4) Fire protection services;
11	(5) General construction and finishing; and
12	(6) Excavation, site preparation and landscaping.
13	(b) These specifications shall be drawn so as to permit
14	separate and independent bidding upon each of these subdivisions of
15	work. All contracts awarded by the state, a political subdivision
16	of the state or by any officer, board or agency of the state, for
17	the erection, construction, reconstruction or alteration of
18	buildings, or any part thereof, shall award the subdivisions of the
19	above specified work separately in a manner consistent with
20	applicable statutes and rules. Nothing in this section prevents the
21	state or any political subdivision from performing any such
22	branches of work by or through their regular employees, or in the
23	case of public institutions, by the inmates of public institutions.
24	(c) Each bidder on a public work contract shall, within two

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1	hours of bid opening, provide a list that names each subcontractor
2	that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract for:
3	(1) Plumbing;
4	(2) Heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus;
5	(3) Electrical;
6	(4) Fire protection services;
7	(5) General construction and finishing; and
8	(6) Excavation, site preparation and landscaping.
9	The list of subcontractors shall include the West Virginia
10	contractor's license number for each subcontractor named. Any
11	change of subcontractor requires the approval of the public owner,
12	upon a showing presented to the public owner of the legitimate
13	construction need for the change, which shall be open to public
14	inspection. Legitimate construction need includes, but is not
15	limited to, a change in project specifications, a change in
16	construction material costs or a change to subcontractor status, if
17	the subcontractor has become otherwise unwilling, unable or
18	unavailable to perform the subcontract.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a requirement for multiple prime contract bids on certain public works projects.
