20	§20-5-19a. Discounts for members of the West Virginia National
21	Guard and the West Virginia Reserves.
22	The director shall issue a discount card to members of the
23	West Virginia National Guard and members of the West Virginia

- 1 Reserves which would provide a fifty percent reduction in
- 2 campground rental fees for each campsite to be used exclusively by
- 3 the eligible camper. In order to be eligible for the reduction,
- 4 the person shall document that he or she is a member of the West
- 5 Virginia National Guard or the West Virginia Reserves. The
- 6 director shall promulgate rules in accordance with article three,
- 7 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code setting forth the documentation
- 8 which is necessary to prove that he or she is a member of the West
- 9 Virginia National Guard or the West Virginia Reserves.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a fifty percent discount to members of the West Virginia National Guard and the West Virginia Reserves in campground rental fees in state parks. The bill also provides for rulemaking.
