11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Athletic Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating
14 to mixed martial arts.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Athletic Commission.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22 twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under
23 the authority of section three-a, article five-a, chapter twenty-
24 nine, of this code, modified by the Athletic Commission to meet the

1 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
2 refiled in the State Register on the sixth day of January, two
3 thousand twelve, relating to the Athletic Commission (mixed martial
4 arts, [177 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Athletic
7 Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Mixed
8 Martial Arts.
