11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a
14 legislative rule relating to shampoo assistants.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the

1 authority of section eleven-a, article twenty-seven, chapter
2 thirty, of this code, relating to the Board of Barbers and
3 Cosmetologists (shampoo assistants, [3 CSR 8](#)), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
6 Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
7 relating to Shampoo Assistants.
