10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Division of Corrections to promulgate a legislative rule  
13 relating to fees for electronic monitoring of offenders.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

15 That article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND**  
18 **PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-6-1. Division of Corrections.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
21 twenty-third day of May, two thousand eleven, authorized under the  
22 authority of section fourteen, article one, chapter twenty-five, of  
23 this code, modified by the Division of Corrections to meet the  
24 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and

1 refiled in the State Register on the twentieth day of July, two  
2 thousand eleven, relating to the Division of Corrections (fees for  
3 electronic monitoring of offenders, [90 CSR 8](#)), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of  
6 Corrections to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Fees for  
7 Electronic Monitoring of Offenders.
