10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to
13 promulgate a legislative rule relating to law-enforcement
14 training standards.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22 twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under
23 the authority of section three, article twenty-nine, chapter
24 thirty, of this code, modified by the Governor's Committee on

1 Crime, Delinquency and Correction to meet the objections of the
2 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
3 Register on the third day of January, two thousand twelve, relating
4 to the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction
5 (law enforcement training standards, [149 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

7 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's
8 Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a
9 legislative rule relating to Law Enforcement Training Standards.
