21	The commission shall have the power to prescribe rules and
22	regulations shall propose rules for legislative approval in
23	accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twenty-
24	nine-a of this code to give effect to the powers vested in it by

1 this chapter. <u>On or before July 1, 2012, the commission shall</u> 2 propose rules requiring mandatory training for all persons who 3 <u>serve any alcoholic liquor beverage, as defined in section five of</u> 4 <u>this article, and subject to regulation by this chapter.</u> Rules and 5 regulations shall be recorded in a book especially kept for that 6 purpose, and in its discretion may be published for general 7 circulation. All other records and entries necessary to show the 8 official conduct of the commission shall be preserved and shall be 9 public records and open for inspection during business hours.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require training of all persons who service alcoholic beverages.
