H. B. 4257

(BY DELEGATES IAQUINTA, POORE, MARSHALL, CROSIER, FLEISCHAUER AND DUKE) [BY REQUEST OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE]

[Introduced January 23, 2012; referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §3-2-6a, relating to late voter registration for any member of a uniformed service of the United States, as defined in 42 U.S.C §1973ff-6, any member of the Merchant Marine of the United States, any person who resides temporarily outside of the United States, and the spouse or dependent residing with a person that fits the criteria.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §3-2-6a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. REGISTRATION OF VOTERS.

§3-2-6a. Extended time for certain persons to register in person.

- (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section six of this 1 2 article, the following persons are entitled to register in person at the office of the clerk of the county commission up to, but 3 4 not including, the day of the election: (1) Any member of a uniformed service of the United 5 States, as defined in 42 U.S.C. §1973ff-6 (7), who is on 6 7 active duty; 8 (2) Any member of the Merchant Marine of the United 9 States; (3) Any person who resides temporarily outside of the 10 11 United States; and 12 (4) Any spouse or dependent residing with a person listed in subdivision 1, 2 or 3 of this subsection. 13 14 The provisions of this subsection apply only to those
- 15 persons who are otherwise qualified to register and who, by
- 16 reason of such active duty or temporary overseas residency,
- 17 either; (i) Are normally absent from the county in which they

reside; or (ii) have been absent from such county and
returned to reside there during the twenty-one days
immediately preceding the election.

- 21 (b) Any person who was on active duty as a member of
- 22 <u>a uniformed service of the United States and discharged from</u>
- 23 the uniformed service during the sixty days immediately
- 24 preceding the election, and the member's spouse or
- 25 dependent, are entitled to register, if otherwise qualified, in
- 26 person up to, but not including, the day of the election.
- 27 (c) The Secretary of State shall prescribe procedures for
- 28 the addition of persons registered under this section to the
- 29 <u>lists of registered voters.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide late voter registration opportunities to individuals covered by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Act of 1986 for a period up to, but not to include, election day.

§3-2-6a is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
